

# DinghyGo Orca Inflatable 3-in-1 Series Powered to Success by Passionate Fans

*How community-driven innovation has shaped the future of portable sailing*

**BOOT Düsseldorf 2026, January 17** — The DinghyGo Orca series is more than just a boat; it is a community-driven success story. For nearly thirteen years, DinghyGo has evolved its inflatable sailing dinghies based on real-world feedback, creating a line that embodies freedom, portability, and performance. From the first inflatable model in 2013 to the Orca 325 in 2019 and now the highly anticipated refreshed Orca 375 (latest version arriving in April 2026), each generation reflects the enthusiasm and ideas of its users.

As the successor to the lightweight DinghyGo Nomad series, the Orca series introduced additional user-requested improvements. The Orca 280 brought a stronger high-pressure floor and sportier handling, followed by the more spacious and robust Orca 325. The new Orca 375 now offers a true family-sized sailing experience, complete with a jib for added performance. Its distinctive black-and-white design has made the Orca the most recognizable and successful DinghyGo line across Europe.

The hallmark of DinghyGo is its 3-in-1 versatility — equally capable of rowing, motoring, and sailing. Combined with its compact storage size, the Orca has become a favourite for spontaneous adventures. German filmmaker and sailor Joscha Seehausen recently showcased this spirit in his YouTube video (YouTube channel: [@JoschaSeehausen](#)) about taking the Orca 375 to Sweden. Joscha, along with many other Orca owners, praises the boat's remarkable stability, making it one of its most celebrated qualities.

Early adopters in the Netherlands, Germany, and the United Kingdom embraced DinghyGo for its practicality, with one German fan calling it "a *practical sailboat for the trunk*." More recently, sailors across Eastern Europe and the USA have been drawn to the Orca's blend of lightweight and sportive performance. Continuous refinement — including lighter materials, composite components, stiff high-pressure floors, larger sails, kick-up rudders, reefing options, and the new 2026 jib sheet cleats — reflects DinghyGo's ongoing dialogue with its community.
